Many reasons explain this intense interest in charr biology. This volume comprises a selection of papers presented at the fourth International Charr Symposium held in Trois-Rivières (Québec, Canada), from 26 June to 1 July 2000. It includes 31 papers on ecological interactions and behaviour, trophic polymorphism, movement and migration, ecophysiology and evolutionary genetics, ecological parasitology, environmental stress and conservation. These studies cannot cover all recent developments in the ecology, behaviour and conservation of *Salvelinus* species, but collecting them into a special volume should bring attention to current research on this important genus and stimulate further work on *Salvelinus* species.
